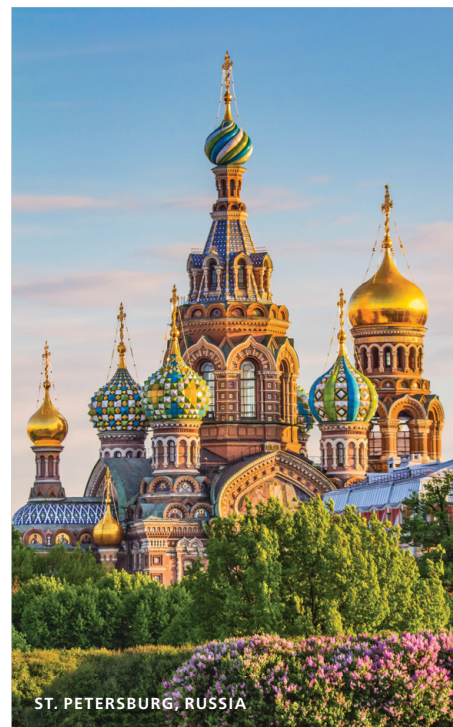

DAY 9	BERLIN (WARNEMÜNDE), GERMANY Discover the fairytale-like Schwerin Castle, or join us on a journey to Berlin, one of Europe's most iconic cities.
DAY 10	COPENHAGEN, DENMARK See Tivoli Gardens, Amalienborg Palace and the Little Mermaid statue, close to our berth in the city centre.
DAY 11	ÅLBORG, DENMARK Explore this charming city on foot, indulge in an Aquavit or explore Fyrkat Viking Fortress.
DAY 12	STAVANGER, NORWAY Walk the Old Town and take in Europe's largest gathering of wooden buildings from the 17th and 18th centuries.
DAY 13	EIDFJORD, NORWAY Capture sweeping mountain views, learn about nature or tour fertile farmlands.
DAY 14	BERGEN, NORWAY Choose a tour of the Bryggens Museum, ascend Mt. Ulriken via cable car or visit composer Edvard Grieg's home.
DAY 15	BERGEN, NORWAY Disembark your ship or extend your stay in Bergen and Oslo or in fascinating Iceland.

CHRISTIANSBORG PALACE & TIVOLI GARDENS

Enjoy a visit to Copenhagen's Christiansborg Palace, seat of the Danish Parliament and house of the Queen's Royal Reception Rooms. Take a short drive to Tivoli Gardens amusement park, where you can stroll through the theatre, bandstands and flower gardens. Bask in the traditions of the early 20th-century atmosphere and enjoy one of the iconic rides.

OLD TOWN TALLINN & CHOCOLATE WORKSHOP

Enjoy a sweet introduction to the highlights of Tallinn's Lower Town and the Kalev chocolate shop's delectable treats. Here you can sample the famous Tallinn confection, marzipan. Climb the stairs to the chocolate workshop and spend an entertaining two hours learning the skills of a chocolate Master Confectioner.

VINTAGE TRAIN RIDE, STOCKHOLM

Step back in time as you embark on a journey to ride the historic rails of the Upsala-Lenna railway. Climb on board and set off as you settle back in your vintage train carriage that dates back to the late 1800s. You'll pass more of Sweden's historic landmarks, stunning nature and landscapes dotted with medieval churches.

PRIVILEGED ACCESS: THE HERMITAGE BEHIND CLOSED DOORS

In St. Petersburg, join a local guide for a tour of the museum's collection, including both masterpieces and the Hermitage's grand spaces, such as the magnificent Jordan Staircase. Then head by motor coach to the city's suburbs and step behind closed doors with your guide for privileged access to the restoration and exhibit centre.

AMBER MUSEUM & GDAŃSK

Discover the history of Baltic amber at Gdańsk's Amber Museum and see highlights of the city's historic Old Town. The Amber Road, an ancient trade route for these semi-precious stones, is deeply rooted in history. At the Amber Museum, learn about how this refined gemstone is created, the history of the trade routes and amber's medicinal uses.

EIDFJORD FROM ABOVE

Experience the stunning beauty of the Norwegian landscape from high above during this exciting airborne excursion. Fly over the vast ice fields of the Folgefonna Glacier. Comprised of a group of three glaciers, it covers 80 square miles. Pass the Hardanger Bridge — the longest suspension bridge in Norway — and into the scenic Hardangerfjord.

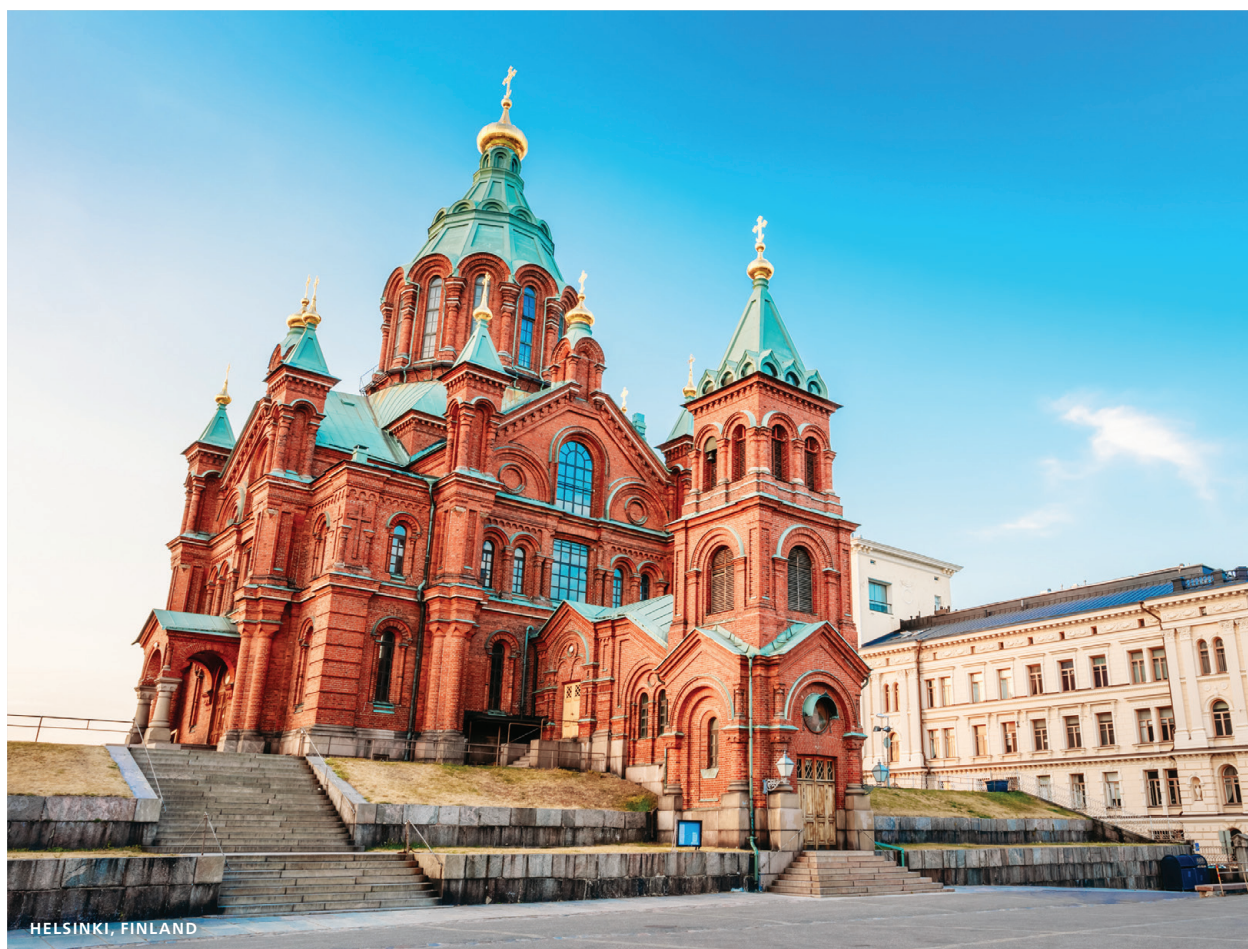
